The Friends of the Escarpment Parks (Toowoomba) Inc. is a volunteer community group that has been helping Toowoomba City Council, Toowoomba Regional Council, National Parks, University of Queensland and others in the regeneration of Toowoomba's bushland parks for nearly twenty years. During this time we have been involved with many of our bushland parks, principally through the removal of exotic woody weeds but also with replanting, monitoring, nest boxes and other activities.

We published an earlier booklet on the environmental weeds of Toowoomba and their control, and are also involved with the Richmond Birdwing Butterfly Recovery program and in other related projects.
