

## Easter cassia - *Senna pendula* var. *glabrata*

**Form:** Brittle erect shrub 1-4m tall.

**Leaves:** Bright green, pinnate, with 3-6 pairs of oval rounded leaflets each 2-5cm long, with a small gland between the lowest pair of leaflets.

**Flowers:** Autumn. Conspicuous masses of bright yellow flowers each 2-3cm across at tips of branches.

**Fruits:** Autumn and winter. Slender pods 8-12cm long each containing 5-10 large flat seeds.

**Impacts:** Slight unless dense; conspicuous when flowering.

**Control:** Seedlings and plants; hand pull or dig. Cut stump or basal bark spray. See DPI Fact Sheet for current herbicide recommendations.

**Ongoing management:** Check area every second year and control new and regenerating plants before flowering.
